### RESOLVE

To provide for the establishment of an Industrial School at the Massachusetts Reformatory and for other purposes.

1 *Resolved*, That there be allowed and paid out of the  
2 treasury of the Commonwealth the sum of seven thousand  
3 dollars, to be expended at the Massachusetts Reformatory  
4 under the direction of the commissioners of prisons, for  
5 the following purposes: For the establishment of an  
6 industrial school, five thousand dollars; for preparing a  
7 dining-room for prisoners in the first grade, and for the  
8 purchase of furniture for the same, a sum not exceeding  
9 two thousand dollars.
