AN ACT

To further enlarge the Area for the Proposed Marine Park of the City of Boston, between South Boston and Castle Island.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The board of park commissioners  
2 of the city of Boston, subject to the provisions of  
3 chapter nineteen of the Public Statutes, except-  
4 ing so much of section sixteen of said chapter  
5 nineteen as requires the payment into the treasury  
6 of compensation for the rights and privileges  
7 hereby granted in land of the Commonwealth,  
8 may make such excavation and filling, and erect  
9 and maintain such structures, in and over the  
10 area of tide-water at or near Dorchester Point in

11 South Boston which lies east of the westerly line  
12 of Q street, extended southerly into Old Harbor,  
13 and northerly to the southerly line of the reserved  
14 channel, as established by the board of harbor and  
15 land commissioners and approved by the gov-  
16 ernor and council under chapter forty-six of the  
17 resolves of the year eighteen hundred and eighty-  
18 six, and south of the said southerly line of said  
19 reserved channel, as the said board may deem  
20 necessary or desirable for the purposes of a public  
21 park, in accordance with the provisions of chapter  
22 one hundred and eighty-five of the acts of the  
23 year eighteen hundred and seventy-five.

1    SECT. 2. All lands of the Commonwealth  
2 which are occupied or enclosed under the pro-  
3 visions of this act shall be appropriated to and  
4 used solely for the purposes of a public park.

1    SECT. 3. This act shall take effect upon its  
2 passage.
