AN ACT

Concerning Alien Passengers.

**BE** it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives, in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :

1 The treasurers of every town and city in this Com-  
2 monwealth shall pay into the treasury of the Com-  
3 monwealth the sums now remaining in their hands,  
4 received from alien passengers; and said town and  
5 city treasurers shall, annually, hereafter, in the month  
6 of May, pay into the treasury of the Commonwealth

7 all balances remaining in their hands, under the pro-  
 8 visions of the two hundred and thirty-eighth chapter  
 9 of the statutes of the year one thousand eight hundred  
 10 and thirty-seven.
