AN ACT

To incorporate the Wachusett House Company.

BE it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives, in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :

1 SECT. 1. Joseph Battestell, Charles Russell,
2 Newton Carpenter, Charles T. Russell, their asso-
3 ciates and successors, are hereby made a corporation,
4 by the name of the Wachusett House Company, for
5 the purpose of erecting and maintaining a hotel and
6 the buildings and improvements connected there-
7 with, on some convenient site in the town of Prince-
8 ton ; and for these purposes shall have all the pow-

9 ers and privileges, and be subject to all the duties,
10 restrictions and liabilities, set forth in the thirty-
11 eighth and forty-fourth Chapters of the Revised
12 Statutes ; *provided, however*, that the said corporation
13 shall not carry on the business of hotel keeping, and
14 *provided, further*, that said corporation shall not per-
15 mit the sale of intoxicating drinks in their house.

1 SECT. 2. The whole amount of real and personal
2 estate, or capital stock which said corporation may
3 hold, shall not exceed the sum of fifty thousand
4 dollars.

1 SECT. 3. This act shall take effect from and after
2 its passage.
