AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE REFUND OF AUTOMOBILE SALES TAX TO HELEN BERGMAN OF WILMINGTON.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Notwithstanding the provisions of chapter 64H of the General  
2 Laws the commissioner of the department of revenue with the  
3 approval of the treasurer of the commonwealth is hereby autho-  
4 rized and directed to refund the sum of three hundred and ninety  
5 dollars out of any available funds to Helen Bergman of  
6 Wilmington which represents the amount of sales tax paid for the  
7 purchase of her car which car was returned to the owner after the  
8 period for filing an abatement had expired.
