AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE USE OF TAX REVENUES FROM CASINO GAMBLING.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Notwithstanding the provisions of any general or special law to
2 the contrary, any tax revenues received by the commonwealth
3 from the operation of casino gambling, so called, shall be allo-
4 cated by the state treasurer in the following manner: fifty percent
5 in the local aid fund and fifty percent shall be used for the school
6 building assistance program of the department of education.
