AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE GOVERNING COMMITTEE OF THE MEDICAL MALPRACTICE REINSURANCE PLAN.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 10 of chapter 330 of the acts of 1994 is hereby
2 amended by striking out the second paragraph and inserting in
3 place thereof the following paragraph:—

4 Such plan shall be prepared and administered by a governing
5 committee for terms of three years consisting of six members,
6 with five members representing medical malpractice insurers, and
7 one member being an independent insurance agent from
8 Massachusetts and nominated from the Professional Independent
9 Insurance Agents of Massachusetts. At least three members of the
10 governing committee shall be representatives of any domestic
11 medical malpractice insurer(s).

12 At least one member shall be a representative of a non-
13 domestic medical malpractice insurer. The governing committee
14 shall be responsible for the hiring of the employees of the plan.
