## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Ninety-Seven.

AN ACT TO INSURE PAYMENT FOR OFF-DUTY OR SPECIAL DETAIL WORK.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 53C of Chapter 44 of the General Laws, as appearing in  
2 the 1992 Official Edition, is hereby amended in the first paragraph  
3 by inserting after the last sentence, the following: — All money  
4 payable to a city, town or district for such services shall be due  
5 and payable within ten days upon receipt of services. Failure to  
6 remit payment within said ten days shall be cause for immediate  
7 suspension of any and all permits or licenses issued by said city,  
8 town or district to the business or individual for whom the off-  
9 duty work has been performed.
