## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Ninety-Seven.

An Act pertaining to the issuance of hunting and fishing licenses in the commonwealth.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Notwithstanding any provision of the Massachusetts General
- 2 Laws to the contrary, there shall be no fee for the granting of a
- 3 license or permit for hunting or fishing in the Commonwealth if
- 4 the applicant shows proof that he or she is sixty-two years or older
- 5 at the time of application for said license or permit.
