AN ACT PROVIDING FOR COMMUTER REPRESENTATION ON THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE MASSACHUSETTS BAY TRANSPORTATION AUTHORITY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 6 of Chapter 161A of the General Laws is hereby
2 amended by inserting after the first paragraph: —

3 Of the six directors appointed by the Governor, no fewer than
4 three shall be designated by the Governor as “commuter direc-
5 tors.” Each commuter director shall certify, no later than the 31st
6 day of January in each and every year of her term, that she uses a
7 regularly scheduled authority vehicle, at least four days a week on
8 average, to commute to and from school, medical appointments or
9 her place of work. Such certification shall be in writing and deliv-
10 ered to the Governor. In addition to the provisions of the
11 following paragraph, any director designated a commuter director
12 who fails to certify as provided above, shall be removed as a
13 director of the authority by the governor unless another director
14 who was not previously designated a commuter director certifies
15 to the governor as provided above.
