AN ACT RELATIVE TO HIGHER EDUCATION COORDINATING COUNCIL AND OTHER BOARDS OF HIGHER EDUCATION.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Section 4 of Chapter 15A of the General Laws is  
2 hereby amended by inserting the words "at least two shall be  
3 members of AFL-CIO labor organizations" at the end of the first  
4 sentence.

1 SECTION 2. Section 8 of Chapter 15A of the General Laws is  
2 hereby amended by adding the following new language:  
3 The council shall appoint a member of an AFL-CIO organiza-  
4 tion to all boards, task forces, commissions, study groups, etc.  
5 which the council feels are necessary to be established.

1 SECTION 3. Section 21 of Chapter 15A of the General Laws  
2 is hereby amended by striking the word "eleven" in the first sen-  
3 tence and substituting the word "twelve".

1 SECTION 4. Section 21 of Chapter 15A of the General Laws  
2 is hereby amended by adding to the second paragraph the  
3 following new language:  
4 Provided further that one member shall be appointed who is a  
5 member of an AFL-CIO labor organization.
