## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Ninety-Seven.

### AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE OPERATION OF UNREGISTERED MOTOR VEHICLES.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 9 of chapter 90 of the General Laws, as appearing in  
2 the 1992 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after  
3 the penultimate sentence the following sentence: — Any person  
4 who is found to be operating a motor vehicle in violation of this  
5 section by a police officer, shall be allowed to return such vehicle  
6 to the place where it is principally garaged, provided such person  
7 is not arrested for a violation of any other law, before any  
8 impoundment action is undertaken.
