AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE ORDER OF PLACEMENT OF JASON S. STOWERS ON THE CIVIL SERVICE ELIGIBILITY LIST.

1 *Whereas*, The deferred operation of this act would tend to
2 defeat its purpose, which is to immediately affect the order of
3 placement of a certain person on the civil service eligibility list,
4 therefore it is hereby declared to be an emergency law, necessary
5 for the immediate preservation of the public convenience.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Notwithstanding the provisions of section twenty-six of chapter
2 thirty-one of the General Laws or any other general or special law
3 to the contrary, Jason S. Stowers, of the city of Medford, the son
4 of a retired police officer who is totally disabled, shall have his
5 name certified for original appointment to the police service
6 before all other persons on the eligible list for such appointment,
7 provided, that he passes the required written and physical exami-
8 nations for entrance to the police service.
