By Mr. Hynes of Marshfield (by request), petition of John Allen that provision be made for payment of salaries to state employees who served in Operation Desert Shield and Operation Desert Storm in the Persian Gulf. Public Service.

AN ACT PROVIDING FOR PAYMENT OF SALARY TO STATE EMPLOYEES SERVING IN DESERT SHIELD AND DESERT STORM.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Notwithstanding the provisions of any general or special law to
2 the contrary, any person employed by the commonwealth who is a
3 member of a reserve component of the armed forces of the United
4 States or the National Guard and has been called to active duty by
5 the President of the United States to serve in Desert Storm or Desert
6 Shield shall be entitled to receive his pay as an employee of the
7 commonwealth in an amount as provided for in this section. Said
8 pay shall be in an amount equal to the difference between the
9 amount which such employee receives for such active duty service,
10 including without limitation any quarters allowance, and the amount
11 of pay which such employee would have received from the com-
12 monwealth had such employment not been so interrupted.
