AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE RETIREMENT RIGHTS OF POWER PLANT EMPLOYEES AT PUBLIC HIGHER EDUCATION INSTITUTIONS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 3(g) of Chapter 32 of the Massachusetts General Laws
- 2 is hereby amended by including all power plant employees at
- 3 public higher education institutions and the appropriate trade per-
- 4 sonnel in the following titles to Group 4:—
- 5 1st Class Power Plant Engineer
- 6 2nd Class Power Plant Engineer
- 7 3rd Class Power Plant Engineer
- 8 Technical Specialist
- 9 Maintenance Foreman Working
- 10 Steam Fireman
- 11 Power Plant Attendant
- 12 Maintenance Equipment Operator
- 13 Metal Worker
- 14 Steamfitter
- 15 Plumber/Steamfitter
