AN ACT TO RECONSTRUCT AND MAINTAIN THE SEAWALL AT MARSHFIELD.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 Pursuant to the 1939 opinion of the Attorney General, that the
- 2 seawall erected by the Commonwealth in Marshfield is to be
- 3 treated as property of the Commonwealth and to be maintained by
- 4 the Commonwealth, there is hereby appropriated five million
- 5 dollars for the reconstruction and maintenance of this seawall
- 6 in Marshfield.
- 7 Appropriation . . . . . \$5,000,000.
