**The Commonwealth of Massachusetts**

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Ninety-Seven.

AN ACT RELATIVE TO FURTHER REGULATING THE MANUFACTURE, TRANSMISSION AND DISTRIBUTION OF ELECTRICITY.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 Chapter 164 of the General Laws, as so appearing, is hereby
- 2 amended by adding at the end thereof the following section: —
- 3 Section 134. Any corporation, person or entity engaged in the
- 4 manufacture, transmission, or distribution of electricity shall
- 5 implement programs to ensure and maintain a workplace free
- 6 from the use of illegal drugs, in order to reduce the risk of danger
- 7 to life, the environment, public health and safety. Such programs
- 8 shall include random drug testing of employees, drug testing of
- 9 employees as a result of an occurrence, and drug testing of
- 10 employees on the basis of reasonable suspicion. Such programs
- 11 shall also include employee counseling, referral services and edu-
- 12 cational services concerning illegal drug use. The definitions,
- 13 standards and guidelines for such programs shall conform to the
- 14 provisions of the United States Department of Energy's
- 15 Workplace Substance Abuse Programs as set forth in 10 CFR 707.
