AN ACT FURTHER REGULATING HANDICAPPED PARKING.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 21 of chapter 40 of the General Laws, as appearing in
- 2 the 1994 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after the
- 3 word "Required" in line 181 the following: — provided, however,
- 4 where the parking space is designed for parallel parking, such
- 5 space shall be painted white and marked "Handicapped Parking".
