AN ACT RELATIVE TO CONTINUING EDUCATION OF FIRE FIGHTERS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary any
- 2 municipality in the Commonwealth may grant the provisions of
- 3 the "Quinn Bill" so called to their fire department personnel so as
- 4 to advance the educational incentives of their community fire
- 5 fighting force.
