AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE MIDDLESEX COUNTY RETIREMENT SYSTEM.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Notwithstanding any general or special law or chapter 306 of
2 the Acts of 1996 to the contrary, the Middlesex County
3 Retirement Board shall consist of:

4 The County Treasurer, who shall be a member ex officio and
5 serve as chairman, two members hereinafter referred to as the
6 elected members, and two members of the county retirement
7 board advisory council who shall be elected by a majority of those
8 present and voting at a public meeting of said council, properly
9 posted, called specifically for such election pursuant to para-
10 graph (g). The election of the elected member shall be run in
11 accordance with the provisions of paragraph (h).
