AN ACT FURTHER REGULATING COLLECTIVE BARGAINING.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 7 of Chapter 150E of the General Laws, as appearing in
2 the 1992 Official Edition, is amended by deleting, in line 107,
3 after the word "eleven B", the words "the terms of the collective
4 bargaining agreement shall prevail", and adding, in line 108, the
5 following:— (r) Section 27 of Chapter 31, the terms of the collec-
6 tive bargaining agreement shall prevail.
