AN ACT FURTHER REGULATING THE MOTOR VEHICLE EXCISE TAX.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 1 of chapter 60A of the General Laws, as
2 appearing in the 1994 Official Edition, is hereby amended by
3 striking out in lines 110 to 112 the following words: — “months
4 in said year following the month preceding that in which the
5 motor vehicle or trailer is registered bears to twelve.” and
6 inserting in place thereof the following: — days in said year
7 following the day on which the motor vehicle or trailer bears to
8 the number of days in the year.

1 SECTION 2. Said section 1 of said chapter 60, as so
2 appearing, is hereby further amended by striking out in lines 128
3 to 130 the following words: — “months in said year remaining
4 after the month in which said transfer by sale or otherwise or such
5 surrender or expiration of registration occurs bears to twelve” and
6 inserting in place thereof the following: — days in said year
7 remaining after the day on which said transfer by sale or other-
8 wise on such surrender or expiration of registration occurs bears
9 to the number of days in the year.
