AN ACT RELATIVE TO PRELIMINARY PLANS TO SUBDIVIDE LAND.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 258 of the Acts of nineteen hundred and ninety-six is
2 hereby amended in section 6, line 17, after the words "ninety-six",
3 by replacing the period with a comma and by inserting in place
4 thereafter the following:— or (iv) a plan has been submitted under
5 section eighty-one S of chapter forty-one, as defined in section
6 eighty-one L of chapter forty-one of the General Laws, on or
7 before August seventh, nineteen hundred and ninety-six.
