**The Commonwealth of Massachusetts**

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Ninety-Seven.

AN ACT RELATIVE TO CERTAIN CREDIBLE SERVICE FOR JOHN D. COYLE, JR.,  
CHIEF OF THE NORTH ATTLEBOROUGH POLICE DEPARTMENT.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of any general or  
2 special law to the contrary, John D. Coyle, Jr., chief of the police  
3 department of the town of North Attleborough, is hereby autho-  
4 rized to continue in such position until and including August 7,  
5 1999, provided that he is mentally and physically capable of per-  
6 forming the duties of his office or position. No further deductions  
7 shall be made from the regular compensation of said employee  
8 under the provisions of chapter thirty-two of the General Laws for  
9 service subsequent to August 7, 1996, and upon retirement said  
10 employee shall receive a superannuation retirement allowance  
11 equal to that to which he would have been entitled had he retired  
12 on said date.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
