AN ACT TO EXEMPT CERTAIN DISABLED VETERANS FROM PAYMENT OF THE MOTOR VEHICLE EXCISE TAX.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section one of chapter 60A of the General Laws, as appearing
2 in the 1994 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after
3 the word "eye" in line 93, the following:— nor to a motor vehicle
4 owned and registered by a World War I, World War II, Korean or
5 Vietnam veteran who has been declared 100% permanently and
6 totally disabled by the Veterans Administration, and as such has
7 been found qualified by the Medical advisory Board, as estab-
8 lished by section eight C of Chapter 90, to receive recognition of
9 the Commonwealth granted through the passing of Chapter 424 of
10 the Acts of 1991.
