AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE REISSUANCE OF REVOKED MOTOR VEHICLE CERTIFICATES OF REGISTRATION.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 1A of Chapter 90 of the General Laws is hereby
2 amended by striking the third sentence and by adding, after the
3 second sentence thereof, the following:—

4 Such certificate of registration, once revoked, may not be re-
5 sued, provided, however, that the registrar may issue a new cer-
6 tificate, bearing a new number, hereinabove mentioned upon the
7 filing of a bond, satisfactory to the department in form and
8 amount, covering all motor vehicles and trailers of the obligor for
9 which application for registration may be made, containing the
10 condition of a motor vehicle liability bond, as defined in section
11 thirty-four A, except as to amount, which bond shall, upon a
12 showing to said department's satisfaction of the obligor's finan-
13 cial ability, be without surety.
