AN ACT TO FURTHER DEFINE RETIREMENT ALLOWANCES FOR FIRE FIGHTERS AND POLICE OFFICERS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Chapter 32 of the General Laws of Massachusetts, as appearing
- 2 in the 1986 Official Edition, is amended by adding in Section 5,
- 3 Sub-Section (2), a new subsection (e), as follows:—
- 4 (e) Any fire fighter or police officer, classified in group 4 of the
- 5 contributory retirement system, as such group is defined in sub-
- 6 paragraph (G) of paragraph (2) of section 3, Chapter 32, of the
- 7 General Laws, who has completed twenty-five (25) years of cred-
- 8 itable service, may apply for and receive a superannuation retire-
- 9 ment allowance of sixty-five percent (65%), or an added
- 10 allowance at a rate of three percent (3%), per year, of creditable
- 11 service, for the years between twenty-five (25) and thirty (30)
- 12 years, at the average annual rate of his regular compensation
- 13 during the period of the last three consecutive years of creditable
- 14 service, for which such rate of compensation was the highest.
