AN ACT EXEMPTING MUNICIPAL MOTOR VEHICLES FROM THE SPECIAL FUELS EXCISE TAX.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Chapter 64E of the General Laws is hereby amended by
- 2 inserting after section 4 the following section:—
- 3 Section 4A. No excise shall be due under this chapter on any
- 4 special fuels which are purchased by any city or town and used for
- 5 any municipal motor vehicles.
