AN ACT RELATING TO CAMP MEETING ASSOCIATIONS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 To amend Chapter 204 of the Acts of 1996 in section 148 to the
- 2 following:—
- 3 For condominiums and Camp-Meeting Associations in existence
- 4 prior to December thirty-first, nineteen hundred and ninety-five for
- 5 purposes of calculating design flows under 310 CMR 15.00 et.
- 6 seq. and 3.14 CMR 5.00 et. seq. and 6.00 et. seq., each septic
- 7 system which has been installed shall be considered a separate and
- 8 distinct facility.
