AN ACT RELATING TO THE BARGAINABILITY OF HEALTH INSURANCE FOR PART-TIME MUNICIPAL EMPLOYEES.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 2 of chapter 32B of the General Laws, as appearing in  
2 the 1992 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after the  
3 first sentence of subsection (d) the following: — Persons who are  
4 ineligible because their duties require less than twenty hours, reg-  
5 ularly, during the regular work week may be provided health  
6 insurance pursuant to the provisions of a collective bargaining  
7 agreement.
