AN ACT RELATIVE TO RT. 143 IN THE TOWNS OF CHESTERFIELD,
WORTHINGTON, WILLIAMSBURG, PERU AND HINSDALE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 That portion of state highway route 143 beginning in the town
- 2 of Williamsburg and extending westerly through the towns of
- 3 Chesterfield, Worthington, Peru and Hinsdale shall be designated
- 4 and known as the General Lafayette Trail. The department of
- 5 highways shall erect and maintain a suitable marker bearing said
- 6 designation.
