AN ACT MAKING CERTAIN CHANGES IN THE APPRENTICE TRAINING LAW.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 11K of Chapter 23 of the General Laws, as most  
2 recently amended is hereby further amended by adding the  
3 following to the first paragraph:— For the purposes of this section  
4 any violation of Sections 26-27H of Chapter 149 of the General  
5 Laws shall constitute a violation of each apprentice agreement  
6 maintained by the employer. Upon certification by the Attorney  
7 General of such violations the director shall disapprove any  
8 existing and future apprentice agreements maintained or proposed  
9 by the employer for a period of three years.
