AN ACT RELATIVE TO CHILD CARE BENEFITS FOR CHILDREN OVER AGE SIX.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any special or general laws to
2 the contrary, parents of children over age six who are in education
3 or job training programs under the Enhanced Enterprise
4 Community and Enterprise Community Initiatives shall receive
5 credit for the twenty hour per week work or community service
6 requirement of the Commonwealth's welfare laws.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
