AN ACT TO ADD FIREARM VIOLATIONS AS DESIGNATED OFFENSE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 99(B)(7) of chapter 272 of the Massachusetts General
2 Laws, as appearing in the nineteen hundred and ninety-four
3 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting, beginning in
4 line 68, after the word "embezzlement", "any offense involving
5 the possession or sale of a firearm, rifle, shotgun, sawed-off
6 shotgun, imitation firearm, machine gun, and ammunition, all as
7 defined in section 121 of chapter 140 of the Massachusetts
8 General Laws."
