AN ACT RELATIVE TO SLIDING TUITION FEES IN INSTITUTIONS OF HIGHER LEARNING.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 The Higher Education Coordinating Council is hereby  
2 authorized and directed to establish a sliding scale of tuition fee  
3 systems for persons attending public institutions of higher  
4 learning. Said tuition charges shall reflect the ability of the  
5 student and his family to pay.
