AN ACT PROVIDING FOR CERTAIN EXTENSIONS OF TIME AS IT RELATES TO CONDOMINIUMS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 26A½ of chapter 148 of the General
2 Laws is hereby amended by striking out in line 27 the word
3 “ninety-one” and inserting in place thereof the following word:—
4 ninety-four.

1 SECTION 2. Said section 26A½ is hereby further amended in
2 line 30 by striking out the word “ninety-four” and inserting in
3 place thereof the following word: — ninety-seventy.

1 SECTION 3. Said section 26A½ is hereby further amended in
2 line 32 by striking out the words “nineteen hundred and ninety-
3 eight” and inserting in place thereof the following words: — two
4 thousand and two.

1 SECTION 4. Said section 26A½ is hereby further amended in
2 line 41 by striking out the word “ninety-four” and inserting in
3 place thereof the following word: — ninety-eight.
