AN ACT ESTABLISHING SPECIAL LICENSE PLATES COMMEMORATING A HUNDRED YEARS OF VOLLEYBALL.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 2 of Chapter 90 of the General Laws, as appearing in
2 the 1992 Official Edition, is hereby amended by adding the fol-
3 lowing paragraph: —
4 The registrar of motor vehicles shall allow the Volleyball Hall
5 of Fame located in Holyoke, subject to all laws and regulations of
6 the registry of motor vehicles, to furnish from its premises distinc-
7 tive temporary commemorative registration plates bearing the des-
8 ignation “Birthplace of Volleyball”, for pleasure passenger vehi-
9 cles owned and operated by residents of the commonwealth. The
10 Volleyball Hall of Fame shall be responsible for designing, manu-
11 facturing or contracting for manufacture, inventory control, pro-
12 motion and distribution of these plates. Owners of pleasure pas-
13 senger vehicles may, upon purchasing “Birthplace of Volleyball”
14 commemorative plates, exchange their present registry plates for
15 these commemorative plates in accordance with normal proce-
16 dures and rates to allow for the official use of said plates. The rev-
17 enues raised by the registration of said plates shall not be deposit-
18 ed in the General Fund, but shall be retained by the registry of
19 motor vehicles to cover the expenses in carrying out the provi-
20 sions of this section. The purchasing price of said commemorative
21 plate shall be determined by the Volleyball Hall of Fame.
