AN ACT ESTABLISHING A MINIMUM PENSION.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter thirty-two of the General Laws, as appearing in the
2 1992 Official Edition, is hereby amended by adding the following
3 section: —

4 Seciton 90C½. Any state employee or member of the state
5 teachers' retirement system who has been retired under the provi-
6 sions of this chapter or similar provision of earlier law on a super-
7 annuation, accidental disability or ordinary disability retirement
8 allowance and who has completed at least twenty-five years of
9 creditable service shall have his retirement allowance increased to
10 an amount not to exceed six thousand dollars; provided that such
11 allowance shall be subject to the provisions of paragraph (e) of
12 section one hundred and two of said chapter thirty-two.
