AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE ASSESSMENT OF LOCAL TAXES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 5, Clause 41B of Chapter 59 of the General Law, as
2 appearing in the 1992 Official Edition, is hereby amended in
3 line 957 by striking the word "ten" and inserting in place thereof
4 the word "seventeen"; and further amend in line 958 by striking
5 the word "twelve" and inserting in place thereof the word
6 "twenty"; and further amend in line 974 by striking the word
7 "twenty" and inserting in place thereof the word "thirty-one"; and
8 further amend in line 974 by striking the word "twenty-three" and
9 inserting in place thereof the word "thirty-seven"; and further
10 amend in line 986 by striking the word "ten" and inserting in
11 place thereof the word "seventeen"; and further amend in line 988
12 by striking the word "twelve" and inserting in place thereof the
13 word "twenty"; and further amend in line 1004 by striking the
14 word "twenty" and inserting in place thereof the word "thirty-one";
15 and further amend in line 1006 by striking the word "twenty-three"
16 and inserting in place thereof the word "thirty-seven".
