AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF HAMPDEN COUNTY TO CONDUCT A FEASIBILITY STUDY OF CERTAIN COURT FACILITIES IN SAID COUNTY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The county commissioners of Hampden county are hereby
2 authorized to expend a sum not exceeding \$150,000 to conduct a
3 study relative to the feasibility of constructing an addition of a
4 fifth floor to the Hall of Justice building in the city of Spring-
5 field, the expansion of the Hampden-Berkshire Juvenile Court
6 District facilities and the programming of a number of court
7 departments within the Hall of Justice, the Hampden Court
8 Building and the Holyoke District Court. The study shall include
9 space planning, major maintenance recommendations, energy
10 conservation, building expansion or new construction as may be
11 required including detailed estimates of the construction and
12 other costs relative thereto. The results of said study shall be filed
13 with the county commissioners of said county.
