AN ACT FURTHER REGULATING APPLICATIONS FOR HEALTH INSURANCE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Subdivision 5 of section 108 of chapter 175 of the General
2 Laws, as appearing in the 1992 Official Edition, is hereby
3 amended by adding the following paragraph: —

4 (d) Any application which asks if the applicant has sought med-
5 ical attention for specific diseases should contain the following
6 language in such question “other than for research purposes.”
