AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE RETIREMENT RIGHTS OF STATE FIRE FIGHTERS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Paragraph (g) of subdivision (2) of section 3 of chapter 32 of
2 the General Laws, as appearing in the 1990 Official Edition, is
3 hereby amended by striking out, in lines 349 and 350, the words
4 “the chief fire warden and district fire wardens in the executive
5 office of environmental affairs.” and inserting in place thereof the
6 following:— the chief fire warden assistant chief of fire control,
7 district fire wardens and fire forest patrolmen in the executive
8 office of environmental affairs and any other employee of the
9 commonwealth whose regular and major duties require them to
10 respond to alarms of fire.
