AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE WORKMAN'S COMPENSATION LAW.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Subsection (4) of section 1 of chapter 152 of the General Laws,
- 2 as appearing in the 1994 Official Edition, is hereby amended by
- 3 adding the following paragraph:—
- 4 The provisions of this chapter shall be elective as to volunteers
- 5 of charitable and non-profit organizations.
