### AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE APPOINTMENT OF THE DISTRICT TREASURER AND DISTRICT CLERK OF THE DALTON FIRE DISTRICT.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Section 9 of chapter 137 of the acts of 1884 is  
2 hereby amended by adding the following sentence:— The district  
3 treasurer and the district clerk of said fire district shall be  
4 appointed by said board of the water commissioners and shall  
5 have all powers and duties vested by law in the offices of the dis-  
6 trict treasurer and district clerk.

1 SECTION 2. The elected district treasurer and district clerk  
2 upon effective date of this act shall continue to hold said offices  
3 and to perform the duties thereof until the expiration of their terms  
4 and the appointment of a district treasurer and district clerk or a  
5 precedent vacating office.

1 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
