Michael Ruane relative to the qualifications and certification of fire prevention offices and inspectors, and the petition (accompanied by bill, House, No. 2167) of Kevin G. Honan for legislation to regulate the use of buildings under the fire prevention laws of the Commonwealth, reports recommending that the accompanying order (House, No. 4374) ought to be adopted.

1     *Ordered*, That the committee on Public Safety be authorized to  
2 sit during a recess of the General Court to make an investigation  
3 and study of House documents, 546 and 2167, and Senate docu-  
4 ments numbered 1097 and 1118, relative to fire issues.

5     Said committee shall report to the General Court the results of  
6 its investigation and study, and its recommendations, if any,  
7 together with drafts of legislation necessary to carry such recom-  
8 mendations into effect, by filing the same with the Clerk of the  
9 House of Representatives on or before the last Wednesday in  
10 December, nineteen hundred and ninety-seven.
