In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Ninety-Seven.

AN ACT RELATIVE TO NARROW THERAPEUTIC DRUGS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Chapter 17 of the General Laws is amended in Section 13 by
- 2 adding at the end of the third paragraph the following:—
- 3 The Commission shall prepare a list of drug products that have
- 4 a narrow therapeutic-toxicity range, identified by the Food and
- 5 Drug Administration, which require careful patient titration and
- 6 monitoring for safe and effective use. This class of drug requires
- 7 special consideration to avoid therapeutic failure and/or potential
- 8 risk to patient safety. A drug product included on this list shall not
- 9 be interchangeable because of the narrow therapeutic-toxicity
- 10 range. The list shall be updated by the Commission.
