AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE RETIREMENT BOARD OF THE TOWN OF NATICK TO PAY A CERTAIN SUM OF MONEY TO EDWARD ZULLO.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Notwithstanding the provisions of chapter thirty-two of the  
2 General Laws, or any other general or special law to the contrary,  
3 the retirement board of the town of Natick is hereby authorized to  
4 pay Edward Zullo, in one sum, an amount equal to the accumu-  
5 lated regular deductions paid by him into the annuity savings fund  
6 of the retirement system of said town together with regular  
7 interest as shall have accrued thereon in accordance with the pro-  
8 visions of sections eleven and twenty-two of said chapter thirty-  
9 two. Payment of said amount to said Edward Zullo shall be an  
10 alternative to and exclusive of any other benefit, allowance, pen-  
11 sion or any other payment to said Edward Zullo from or on  
12 account of service rendered to or of compensation received while  
13 a member of said retirement system.
