AN ACT FURTHER AMENDING THE CONFLICT OF INTEREST LAW.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Notwithstanding Chapter 268A of the Massachusetts General  
2 Laws or any other general or special law to the contrary, Kathleen  
3 Pendergast, Selectman in the Town of Framingham, is authorized  
4 to continue to lease town-owned property in the Town of  
5 Framingham, having entered into said lease by competitive bid  
6 prior to being elected Selectman.
