

missioners, for the fiscal year ending on the thirtieth day of November, nineteen hundred and ten, to wit: —

For the salaries of the commissioners, thirty-nine hundred dollars. Civil service commissioners.

For the salary of the chief examiner, three thousand dollars. Examiner.

For the salary of the secretary, three thousand dollars. Secretary.

For the salary of the registrar of labor, two thousand dollars. Registrar of labor.

For clerical assistance, and for office, printing, travelling and incidental expenses, advertising and stationery, a sum not exceeding thirty-two thousand two hundred dollars. Clerical assistance, etc.

For printing and binding ten thousand copies of the annual report, a sum not exceeding twelve hundred dollars. Annual report.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.

AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR EXPENSES IN CONNECTION WITH THE ESTABLISHMENT OF LIFE INSURANCE DEPARTMENTS BY SAVINGS BANKS.

Chap. 34

*Be it enacted, etc., as follows:*

SECTION 1. A sum not exceeding fifteen thousand dollars is hereby appropriated, to be paid out of the treasury of the commonwealth from the ordinary revenue, for the salaries and expenses in connection with the establishment of life insurance departments by savings banks, for the fiscal year ending on the thirtieth day of November, nineteen hundred and ten, as authorized by chapter five hundred and sixty-one of the acts of the year nineteen hundred and seven. Establishment of life insurance departments by savings banks.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.

AN ACT MAKING APPROPRIATIONS FOR SALARIES AND EXPENSES IN THE BUREAU OF STATISTICS.

Chap. 35

*Be it enacted, etc., as follows:*

SECTION 1. The sums hereinafter mentioned are appropriated, to be paid out of the treasury of the commonwealth from the ordinary revenue, for salaries and expenses in the bureau of statistics, for the fiscal year ending on the Appropriations.
