AN ACT RELATIVE TO ELECTIONS IN THE CITY OF MEDFORD IN THE CURRENT YEAR.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of any general or
2 special law to the contrary, there shall be no preliminary election
3 as otherwise required on September 23, 1997, for the Office of
4 School Committee Member for a two (2) year term; for the Office
5 of City Council for a two (2) year term; and for the Office of
6 Mayor for a two (2) year term; and the candidates whose nomina-
7 tion papers have been duly certified shall be deemed to have been
8 nominated.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
